Kaleidoscope Chamber Collective, hailed for its “exhilarating performances” (The Times), will perform for a Coastal Concerts audience at Cape Henlopen High School Auditorium, 2 P.M., Saturday, December 9, 2023. The concert will be preceded at 1 P.M. by Lani Spahr and his Performance Insights. Kaleidoscope was dreamed up in 2017 by Philadelphia native and Delmarva favorite Elena Urioste with her pianist/composer husband and playing partner, Tom Poster. The Collective’s flexible roster features many of today’s most inspirational musicians, both instrumentalists and singers. Its creative programming is marked by a commitment to celebrating diversity of all forms with a desire to unearth lesser-known gems of the repertoire.

Kaleidoscope broadcasts regularly on BBC Radio 3 and has recently been ensemble-in-residence at Aldeburgh Festival, Kettle’s Yard, and Ischia Music Festival. Kaleidoscope is regularly featured at Elena’s own summer festival, Chamber Music by the Sea, which is centered in Berlin and Snow Hill, MD.

The December 9 concert will feature works by Franz Schubert, Ernő Dohnányi, Jessie Montgomery and Florence Price.
