Coastal Concerts presents Sinta Quartet April 9 2022

Sinta Saxophone Quartet will appear on Coastal Concerts' stage at the Bethel UMC Fellowship Hall, 4th and Market Streets in Lewes at 7:30 P.M., Saturday April 9, 2022, preceded at 6:30 P.M. by Lani Spahr's Performance Insights.

"Virtuosic to the core" (Textura) and hailed as "a tight-knit ensemble exploding with power and virtuosity" (Boston Musical Intelligencer), Sinta Quartet is on a mission to bring the versatility, homogeneity, and excitement of the saxophone to audiences everywhere. Strengthening an already palpable connection with its audience by performing entirely from memory, the quartet provides a fresh take on chamber music that is at once beautiful, virtuosic, and a completely interactive experience.

The four members of SQ grew up in very different parts of the country, meeting at the University of Michigan where they studied with the legendary saxophone professor, Donald Sinta, and decided to name the group after him for the profound influence he had on each member and for his inspirational coaching of the group.

Sinta Quartet's program for the evening takes the audience on an adventure through time, geography, and genre, intertwining classic works by titans J. S. Bach and Beethoven with works by contemporary composers Chris Hass, David Biedenbender, John Mackey, Marc Mellits, and Mark O'Connor.

In 2019, Sinta released their debut recording, "Collider", which was hailed as "An exciting ride! The ensemble, intonation, and technique in this recording are beyond question" (The Saxophonist Magazine). Their second, "Ex Machina", praised as "tightly performed and flawlessly recorded in generous, in-your-face sound" (Musical America), was released in 2020.
